### **USUAL & CUSTOMARY COST SCHEDULE #4**

Usual & Customary Cost Schedule (UCCS) #4 and the associated Standardized Invoice #4 are now available, and are to be used for work performed **beginning August 1, 2008.**

Changes to the UCCS include:

Task 4-Waste Disposal - The cost for drums is no longer included in the commodity subtask unit rates under this task. There is a new subtask, MDT21 under Task 15 - MISCELLANEOUS DRILLING ACTIVITIES AND SUPPLIES, which is for the drum cost only. The cost for drums can now be claimed when invoiced rather than when the waste disposal occurs. This will alleviate the owner having to pay the drum cost up front and then wait until disposal occurs to get reimbursed.

Rate adjustments were based on input and commodity service data provided by consultants, commodity service providers, other state agencies, variance request approval data, and the application of an Inflation Factor (4%) determined from U.S. gross domestic product data (Source : U.S. Bureau Economic Analysis | [www.bea.doc.gov/bea/dn/nipaweb/SS\\_Data/Section1All\\_csv.csv](http://www.bea.doc.gov/bea/dn/nipaweb/SS_Data/Section1All_csv.csv) | Index numbers 2000=100 | NIPA Table 1.1.9. | U.S. Bureau of Economic Analysis.)

Commerce has recognized the need for an increase to the mobilization charges due to rising fuel costs. Therefore, a fuel surcharge has been added to the commodity service mobilization rates. The surcharge was applied to these activities after the overall 4% increase was applied to all tasks on the schedule. The surcharge for consultant mobilizations was incorporated in the state mileage rate which increased from \$0.62 to \$0.66 per mile.

### **OSHKOSH OFFICE MOVES**

After being at the Jackson Street location for more than 10 years, the Site Review Section's Oshkosh office will relocate on July 30, 2008. The relocation will move Oshkosh Site Review personnel to the City Center (the old Park Plaza Mall) located at, 375 City Center, Suite I, Oshkosh, WI 54901-4877. Parking for the new office is located in the lot on Jackson Street accessed via the driveway closest to the Jackson Street Bridge.
